Information presented here is based on interviews with key informants, who were asked to report on migration from their community. Findings presented here are based a purposive sample of respondents from 70 communities in Erbil, Dahuk and Sulayaniya, and should be considered indicative only.

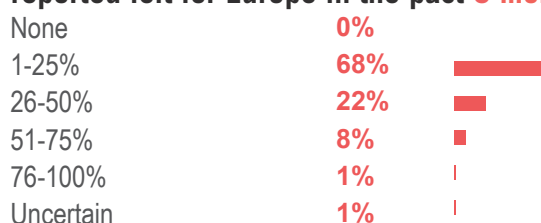

Among assessed communities proportion reported left for Europe in the past month:

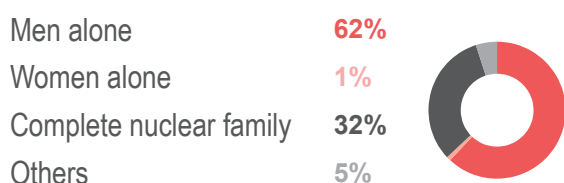


Among assessed communities proportion reported left for Europe in the past 6 months:

Status of reported migrants leaving recently from assessed communities:

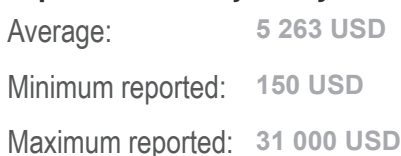

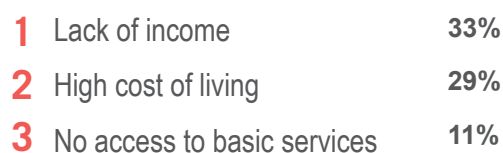

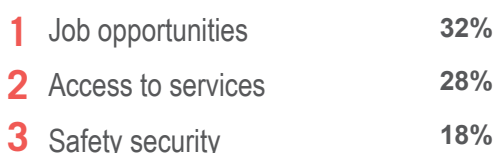
